As a church we normally have 2 meetings on a Sunday, one at 11am and the other at 6pm. The meetings are slightly different from one another and there is great benefit in coming to both if you're able. Both services are available live on Zoom for those unable to attend.

Sundays at 11am is the main church gathering of the week. Alongside the service there is a Sunday School and creche for children. The service itself lasts until 12:20pm and is followed by refreshments. We share the Lord's Supper together on the first Sunday of the month in the morning.

At **6pm on Sunday evenings** we meet again for a more informal service aimed at discipleship and training. As part of the meeting there is opportunity to pray for and with one another, interact with the teaching through discussion and questions, and once a month (third Sunday) we share the Lord's Supper together in an unhurried reflective service.



Church Office




Kids Club, 7-11s
